There will be at least two trophies awarded in each judged category unless in the opinion of the parade committee, there are insufficient entries in the category. The parade committee reserves the right to combine categories as it may deem appropriate. Floats will be judged on construction, theme portrayal and crowd appeal. Majorette corps will be judged by the same judges as are bands. All horse and mule units will be judged by one or more qualified persons. The decisions of the judges are final.

I understand that the parade committee reserves the right to include or exclude entries as deemed appropriate and to determine the parade line-up. The parade committee is not responsible for accidents or injuries.
